## **Safety Policy**

## **COVID Attestation:**

- 1. To attend the Gathering in-person, it is strongly recommended that everyone five and older be fully vaccinated; i.e. two doses of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine or one dose of the J&J vaccine, plus one booster when eligible.
- 2. People with any symptoms should not come.
- 3. Masks, N95 or equivalent, such as a KF-94 or KN-95, are to be worn indoors, except when eating or drinking. Single-layer cloth masks are not effective.
- 4. A supply of masks will be available, but please bring your own.
- 5. Participants are expected to physically distance as possible both indoors and outdoors. If participants develop symptoms of COVID-19 during the gathering, they are asked to test for COVID-19 (we will have a small supply of tests on hand), alert the Registrar of the symptoms and test results, and leave Temescal Canyon (you will be welcome to rejoin us online).
- 6. Participants should promptly alert the Registrar of any positive COVID-19 within five days after the gathering.
- 7. Parents and guardians are responsible for having their children comply with this policy. By registering for the gathering I affirm that I meet the above requirements and will abide by the above guidelines.
- 8. I acknowledge that although SCQM has adopted these COVID protocols, no protocol can assure I will not be exposed to, or contract COVID-19. By attending SCQM in person, I assume that risk. I will do what I can to protect both my health and that of others. If I am sick, I will stay home.
- 9. Overnight sleeping quarters will be assigned by family/household pod, where applicable. Attenders from different households assigned to the same cabin or bungalow will need to socially distance and wear masks as appropriate.
